## NEW TUITION COLLECTION PROCESS

Beginning **February 1st**, 2007, your Kumon Center will be converting the tuition payment process from the current (checks/cash) to Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT). EFT provides for electronic payments and collections. EFT is safe, secure, efficient, and less expensive than paper payments and collections. EFT is becoming a normal business practice where re-occurring charges takes place.

Some of the benefits of EFT include; payments on time, no late fees, no checks to write, no checks to mail. More importantly, your Kumon Center will save increasing costs of processing tuition payments, so that it may continue to provide an affordable service to your child.
